Rising Dragon Values Curriculum

All students train in the values of the White Lotus Association and the Codes and Creeds of Rising Dragon Martial Arts. These virtues such as faith, love, honor, and courage make a cornerstone for the martial arts. But Pee Wee, Little and Junior Dragons (Ages 4-14) have many of these virtues spelled out in classes through values training as part of their curriculum. Many of these protocols and values instill discipline, focus, and respect. Prior to testing a letter is sent to parents asking if they have seen improvement in such values at home – are they addressing parents respectfully, greeting them properly, doing chores, and helping others. If the parents say 'yes' a student is allowed to test. Otherwise they must wait a month in order to make improvements at home and life.
